## **New Adult Sunday School Classes**

Two different Sunday school studies that will be starting on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>February 27</u>: These 12-week studies are both from Ligonier Ministries and have the same format: Each lesson will have a 23-minute message on DVD, followed by discussion and Bible study.

But many Christians today suffer from an identity crisis, unaware of this truth and how this new identity can reshape every aspect of their lives. In this teaching series, Dr. Ferguson explores the crucial meaning of our union with Christ, revealing that being a Christian is far more wonderful than many of us know.
